This year our goal is to raise \$40,000 to meet ongoing needs in Fiji and PNG.

### **How Funds Will Be Used**

#### For PNG:

- Mercy Care School supporting 250 students, teachers' salary, stationary, training and a nurturing care framework which will improve the health and wellbeing of the children;
- Rebuilding a small health clinic in Kalvary, PNG, where we have a remote Church of Christ; and
- Building fund for a future HOPE Community Centre in Port Moresby.

## For Fiji (in partnership with Rosie Holidays):

- Providing food aid to vulnerable families;
- A volunteer trip to refurbish a village clinic; and
- Child minding services, and a kindergarten to provide a safe learning environment for children.
